The feed to the Park pond has now been replaced so it is now back to its normal level.

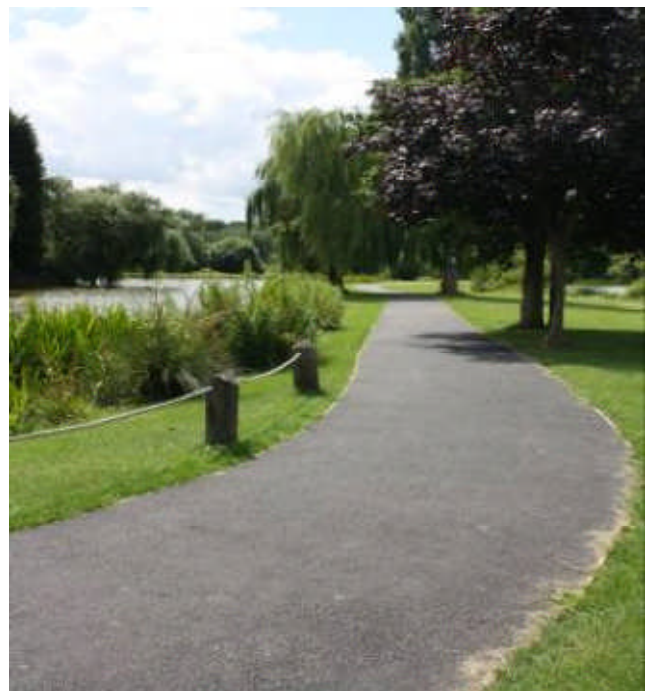
The problem was caused by a collapsed pipe under West Street which feeds water from the canal.

CENTENARY CELEBRATIONS

The Coronation Day of King George V and Queen Mary was 100 years ago, on the 22nd June 1911. To commemorate this Mr J. Chester-Coulman presented this Recreation Ground to the Town Council.

In a small ceremony to mark the occasion the Mayor of Thorne Cllr. Bert-Maurice Chowings rededicated the original bronze plaque which is now mounted in the building.

Representatives of Thorne History Society were present at the ceremony which was hosted by the Thorne Family Support Group who use the New Coulman Pavilion as their base, many of whom were in period costumes.
