

GROUP TO DEVELOP PLANS FOR MOORENDS RECREATION GROUND

A new Working Group has been established to develop proposals to improve Moorends Recreation Ground, including Thorne-Moorends Town Councillors (Cllrs G Derx, S Durant, R Durant and A Farrand) , and representatives of the main users. The aim is to improve the facilities on the site, and look how, in the medium to long term; it can provide high quality facilities for the benefit of the local community. The group is committed to carrying out consultation with the community as proposals are developed.

Chair of the group, Councillor Mark Houlbrook said “The Town Council have put the improvement of the Moorends Recreation Ground as a high priority, and we are pleased to be able to begin to work with the local Sports Clubs who are also keen to deliver improvements. In the short-term we have begun to carry out a number of improvements to make the current facilities more suitable for their current purpose. However I am keen to see the area become a much greater asset for the local community, including the reintroduction of events and galas that were popular in the past.”
